Alain-René Le Sage naquit à Sarzeau, petite ville de la presqu'île de Rhuys, près de Vannes, le 8 mai 1668. Il était fils unique de Claude Le Sage, notaire royal, et de Jeanne Brenugat. Resté de bonne heure orphelin, il se trouva placé sous la tutelle d'un oncle par qui sa fortune fut dissipée. Il fit ses études chez les Jésuites de Vannes, vint les terminer à Paris et se fit recevoir avocat. En 1694, il épouse une femme sans fortune, fille d'un menuisier de la rue de la Mortellerie. A vingt-sept ans il était père de famille, et la profession qu'il exerçait n'était pas lucrative. Il demanda des ressources à la littérature. Sur les conseils de Danchet, son ancien condisciple au collège de Vannes, il fit une traduction des Lettres d'Aristenète, qui parut en 1695 et n'eut aucun succès. Heureusement l'abbé de Lyonne s'intéressa à Le Sage. Il lui procura quelques ressources et sut lui faire partager le goût très-vif qu'il avait pour la littérature espagnole. Cette littérature, après avoir été en grande faveur chez nous, y était alors fort négligée. Elle devint bientôt familière à Le Sage, qui trouva là le champ où devait se développer et mûrir son talent. Il commença par traduire quelques pièces de théâtre: Le Traître puni, de Roxas, imprimé en 1700; Don Félix de Mendoce, de Lope de Vega; Le Point d'honneur, de Rojas, qui fut joué en 1702. Puis il fit une traduction ou plutôt une imitation des Nouvelles Aventures de Don Quichote, d'Avellaneda, qui parut en 1704, et une comédie en cinq actes et en prose, tirée de Calderon, Don César Ursin, qui réussit à la cour et fut sifflée à la ville.
